I, FRANK M. JORDAN, Secretary of State of the State of California, hereby certify:

That on the 2nd day of August, 1956, pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law, Division 12 of the Water Code and more particularly Section 30321 thereof, there was received in this office and filed in the official records thereof:

The Certificate of G. A. Pequegnat, County Clerk of the County of Riverside, under the signature of W. R. Patty, Deputy, stating that the formation of the Pine Cove County Water District was approved by the voters of and residing within the boundaries of the proposed district.

I further certify it is set forth in said Certificate that at the election held on the 3rd day of July, 1956, on the question: "Shall the proposition to form Pine Cove County Water District under the County Water District Law be adopted?" there were 44 votes cast in favor of the formation of such district and one vote against it, determined by the canvass of the votes cast at said election made by the Board of Supervisors on July 9, 1956, and July 23, 1956, the absentee ballots having been canvassed on this latter date.

I further certify that attached to said Certificate is a certified copy of the Resolution adopted by said Board on July 30, 1956, declaring organization of said district and defining the boundaries thereof.

Now, therefore, I further certify that a County Water District situated in the County of Riverside has been duly incorporated according to the laws of the State of California under the name:

Pine Cove County Water District."
